## Match Fees and Deposit Policy Sunday League 2010

(Not including student league)

### **Match Fees**

New team first match: £30

Thereafter £40 each match. After nine matches fully paid at £40 a team's tenth match is £20. This sequence then repeats. To qualify for this or any current money off offers a team's deposit must be paid.

At end2endfootball we have a deposit policy in place to offer our customers as much fixture security as possible. We believe our deposit policy is fair and is to the benefit of the league.

### **Deposit Policy – How it Works**

1.1 The deposit is £32 this is due to be paid by a team by the end of the third week of their participation. This deposit is then returnable to the team when they give notice to leave.

1.2 If a team chooses to withdraw from the league before the current season is complete a £16 charge is due. One season can be seven, eight or nine weeks long. See website for current competition durations.

### **Teams absent from fixtures**

Please try to fulfil all your fixtures and should your team have to miss a match, please make every effort to find a stand in team and give end2endfootball the maximum amount of notice possible

2.1 A team can miss one game a season without charge, for this a minimum one weeks notice is required (IE at least from the previous match day Sunday). A second missed game with one weeks notice during a season and an £8 charge is due. NB if a stand in team can be placed by the absent team or the organisers, who pay £36, the charge to the absent team is waived. If the stand in team pay less than £36 the difference (up to a maximum £8) is due from the absent team.

2.2 When a team has given notice of not being able to play and they are unable to provide a replacement team, end2endfootball will do everything possible to provide a stand in team and will set the match fee for the stand in team to a maximum £36. Although less may have to be offered to stand in teams in order to secure their attendance, subject to stand in team availability and notice that they require.

2.3 Notice from a team that they cannot play received Monday to Thursday prior to a match day Sunday, a £8 charge is due. NB if a stand in team can be placed by the absent team or the

organisers and the Stand in team pay £36, the charge to the absent team is waived. If the stand in team pay less than £36 the difference (up to a maximum £8) is due from the absent team. As an example: typically a stand in team will pay £25 –30 for a match.

2.4 Notice from a team that they cannot play received Friday to Saturday prior to a match day Sunday, a £16 charge is due. NB if a stand in team can be placed by the absent team or the organisers and the stand in team pay £36, the charge to the absent team is waived. If the stand in team pay less than £36 the difference (up to a maximum £16) is due from the absent team. As an example: typically a stand in team will pay £25 –30 for a match.

2.5 Notice from a team that they cannot play received on a Sunday match day, a £20 charge is due. NB if a stand in team can be placed by the absent team or the organisers and the stand in team pay £36, the charge to the absent team is waived. If the stand in team pay less than £36 the difference (up to a maximum £20) is due from the absent team. As an example: typically a stand in team will pay £25 –30 for a match

2.6 No Notice received from a team that they cannot play on a Sunday match day, a £32 charge is due. If a stand in team cannot be placed and the team who were due to play the absent team leave the venue having not played, £10 of the deposit will be due to them in compensation. NB if a stand in team can be placed by the organisers and the stand in team pay £36, the charge to the absent team is waived. If the stand in team pay less than £36 the difference (up to a maximum £32) is due from the absent team. As an example: typically a stand in team will pay £25 –30 for a match. It is unlikely that a full paying stand in team could be found, at such short notice. In the event of a team forfeiting more than £20 of their deposit. Contact with the league organisers would be required to secure their continuation in the league.

2.7 All charges incurred through team absence are due on the date of that team's next fixture, to return the deposit to a full level.

### **Teams playing stand in teams**

3.1 If a team is absent and end2endfootball provide a stand in team that have come in especially to play the absent teams opposition, a full fee will be due from the absent team's opposition (an awarded win can be claimed by the present team or the game can be played for points at the attending team's choosing, as per the Rules of Play).

3.2 If a team is absent and end2endfootball provide a stand in team, to play the absent team's opposition, that is made up of spare players and players who have just played a game etc and they can be described as a reasonable opposition, a full fee will be due from absent teams opposition (an awarded win can be claimed by the present team or the game can be played for points at the attending team's choosing, as per the Rules of Play).

3.3 If the team whose official opposition are absent, reach agreement with the organisers that the stand in team that they play do not constitute a fair and reasonable opposition IE in terms of numbers, too many having just played a game etc, then that teams match fee is reduced by £10.

### **Special offers**

end2endfootball sometimes operates special offers, such as joining and money off offers. These may change at future dates. But only with advance warning to teams and prior to the beginning of a competition

### **Compensation if your team does not play**

If a team attends a match day and they do not play a game due to their opposition not attending, they will be due £10 compensation from end2endfootball via the absent team's deposit. This is in the form of £10 off their next match. NB This is only due if the team leave the venue having not played as a team was not available. Alternative opposition and stand in players including players who have just played count as an available opposition. However if the team whose official opposition are absent, reach agreement with the organisers that the stand in team that play them do not constitute a fair and reasonable opposition IE in terms of numbers, too many having just played a game, players from a different division etc, then that teams match fee is reduced by £10.

### **Discipline fines**

A red card for violent conduct or any other serious offence will lead to a £5 fine for that player, the team is also responsible for payment of this fine. Not all red cards will necessarily be £5 fines. This will be decided after consultation between the organisers and referee. For further details, such as player suspension, please see the 'Rules of Play'. By registering and entering a team in to end2endfootball leagues or playing as an individual player within a team, all participants agree to the previous and following terms and conditions.

### **General terms and conditions**

end2endfootball operates its competitions under a strict code of conduct and adherence to the Rules of Play. By taking part in the league all teams and individual players are agreeing to abide by the 'Rules of Play' and the 'Terms and Conditions'.

All teams must pay their deposits by their third week of participation. All players must read the Rules of Play and the Terms and Conditions and agree to abide by them at all times. All players must be over sixteen years old. All team captains/main contacts will ensure that any suspensions awarded to their players will be followed, as will individual players. All participants entering into end2endfootball sporting activities do so entirely at their own risk and the organisers, their servants or agents, do not accept any liability for any personal injury or loss/damage to property howsoever caused.
